


Showcase the best of your community

1. Desktop and mobile-friendly design

Mobile (cell phone) views account for almost half of web traffic worldwide. Your HOA site needs to look professional on all devices—computers, cell phones, tablets.

2. Events calendar

One of the best ways to ensure owners participate in HOA events is to integrate a community calendar into the website; giving them time to plan to be there.

3. Simple layout

Less is usually more when it comes to website design. Choose a layout that is simple and clean. Ensuring what residents are searching for is easy to find.

4. Secure owner-only access

Having a homeowner password-protected login portal allows your HOA to publish important content that only they can access.

5. Photo gallery

It's always better to show than tell. Including photos of the HOA's amenities and the community property provides a strong visual and helps attract interested buyers.

6. Search bar

Homeowners enter keywords to find exactly what they're looking for quickly.

7. Contact information

Give owners and interested buyers a way to engage with and reach management.

1. Mass communication

Mass emails, text and voice messages deliver communications to your community in minutes, so everyone is informed simultaneously.

2. Events registration


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
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
